

Low-Lite-Shoot Instructions To All Participants

Initial Warning Order:

Date: 18 November 2023 (i.e. minus 30 or plus 30 degrees);

Day: Saturday,

Time: 1600L – 1959L Shoots (Day & LLS)

2030ish BBQ with beverage of your choice -BYO

Cost: \$10 per shooter (includes Hot-Dog)

Free: Spectators (spouses/partners/kids of members) Hot-Dog will be \$5

Cash only - pay at the event at 1600L

Situation:

The Club provides a controlled Low-Lite-Shoot environment for KGAC Club Members only. No visitors allowed – shooters or spectators. Minors of members welcome (you know your kids best)!

Following the LLS there will be a social, the BBQ will be lit-up and the Lease gets shut-down. Both beverages are on a BYO basis If you want more than a Hot-Dog (provided by the Club) bring your own steak;

Intent:

To provide all KGAC members an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the challenges of Low-Lite-Shooting conditions and implement safe-handling drills during a low-lite environment.

Organized events:

- MPR1: Dynamic Rifle I/C DR-Chair;
- MPR2: Rifles static firing line- I/C RSO;
- HG1: Hand-Guns static firing line I/C RSO;
- HG2: Dynamic Handgun I/C DH-Chair;
- Trap: Trap-Shoot I/C Trap-Chair;
- Archery: Archery I/C Archery-Chair;
- An event shooter can participate in more than one event BUT must conduct the day-shoots of all events in order to eligible for the LLS! Take your pick(s).

Organized-and-supervised shooting open to all members:

- MPR2: open for Club Members to shoot under supervision of Assigned Duty-RSO;
- HG1: open for Club Members to shoot under supervision of Assigned Duty-RSO;
- Members can go back-and-forth between the two ranges (MPR2-HG1) IF they participated in both ranges during daytime shooting hours and are on the RSOs-shooters-list; and
- All other Ranges will be closed as of 1530L.

Special:

All shooters AND club-spectators MUST use Red Lite ONLY!;
1 say again;

All shooters AND club-spectators MUST use Red Lite ONLY!;

- No other lite-color is allowed during the time of 1800L-1959L;
- No vehicle entry due to white-lite after 1759L into the Lease / Gate will be manned and any vehicle after 1800L will be denied Lease access members-spectators can walk in (with red-lite-flash-lite) but ya ain't driving;
- FYI: The reason for this strict lite procedure is: It takes the average eye approx. 20-min-plus to readjust to low-lite conditions; and
- All shooters must participate in day-lite Live-Fire in "their-chosen-discipline-event" to be eligible for participation in a Low-Lite-Shoot. No exception.

RSO-help required:

- 1. The Chief-RSO will be taking the overall lead in this event;
- 2. In order to safely execute this event and meets its required safety-protocol and standards the Club requires help from KGAC qualified Range Safety Officers
- 3. Duty from 1545L- till last shot is fired 2000L-ish (Range set-up is prior to 1545L and the RSO is responsible for the set-up);
- 4. RSO's will get a specific safety briefing from the Chief-RSO 1545L- and will be part of the Range-Safety-To All Participants 1600L as well as conducting their individual Range Safety Briefs at their assigned Range;
- 5. RSO's must maintain a written list (provided by Chief) who-participated in day-lite-hours vs Low-Lite-Shooting list;
- All participating Discipline Chairs plus their 2 I/C's;
- 1 x Lease-Gate-Duty RSO, sitting in vehicle blocking entrance 1759L till last shot is fired 1959L;
- 1 x MPR2 Duty-RSO;
- 1 x HG1 Duty-RSO; and
- 1 x Medic.

Lite codes:

• Green glow sticks: Targets are illuminated with green glow-sticks at left-and-right-of-arc of each individual target;

Metal Targets are illuminated in front of the target (at the base);

• Yellow glow sticks: Range Arc-Markers are illuminated with yellow-glow-sticks;

• Red glow sticks: Lease-Flag at the Lease entrance is illuminated with a red-glow-stick;

Range-Flags are illuminated with red-glow-sticks,

Firing-Point-Flags are illuminated with red-glow-sticks;

- Blue glow sticks: RSO's have 2 blue glow sticks (1-in-front & 1-in-the-back);
- Trap will use different means; (dimmed red-lite lites);
- All shooters must have a head-lamp with a red filter;
- <u>No hand-held-lite</u> a shooter must use both hands when operating the gun or conducting Immediate-Action-drills during stoppages;
- Good gun control is using both hands!;
- White lite is allowed after 2000L or in case of a Medical Emergency as per Range Safety Brief;
- Dry-firing on the unload drill is strictly enforced;
- Tracer rounds are allowed.

Timings

1600L Event-Range-Safety-Brief – All personnel (late commers equals non-shooters) – Location: outside of Club House 1610L Individual Range Briefs at active Ranges: MPR1, MPR2, HG1. HG2, Trap and Archery; 1620L Day Lite Shoots to be conducted – course of fire must be the same as Low-Lite-Shoot RSO must do: Create a written mbr list of day-time shooters and compare list with participating LLShooters; Ensure each shooter demonstrates capability to switch to engage Red-Lite - without going to white lite 1^{st!;}; 1720L Break - prep for LLS 1745L Entire Lease on Red-Lite – violation of Red Lite Rule equals termination of the LLS by the guilty operator; 1800L All Ranges illuminated including RSO's wearing yellow glowstick (1 front and 1 back); 1805L LLS-Range Safety Brief by Chief-RSO to all personnel; 1810L LLS-Range safety Brief at individual Ranges; Dynamic Chairs only: Must execute 1-dry-run of the course of fire with ALL participants prior to Conducting live-fire; Enforce strict Red-Lite-Rule; 1959L Last shot fired; 2000L Case all guns and store in motor vehicles; 2005L Clean-up Ranges; and 2030L BBQ starts
