



Safety is an individual responsibility! If you see an unsafe act = You must STOP it! Anyone can call – Stop!

Flag change- RSO: delegate Flag change from Green to Red
Command “STOP”: Explain the command “STOP” 1st before any other command

Range Commands:

Action executed by shooters:

Range going – Hot! -

- 1. PPE on – shut-up - get ready; (Personal Protective EQPT)

(With a ___ rnd mgzn) - Load! -

- 1. Place magazine in gun/feed munition into magazines/breach;

Ready! -

- 1. Cock -/Close- action = Chamber a round;

(On your own time) - Fire! -

- 1. Fire at your own pace/time at your target(s);

Stop! -

- 1. Put gun on safe – wait for further commands;

(Wait For Further Commands)

(Stand-fast: do not talk - do not leave your position, WFFC);

Unload! – **for inspection clear Gun!** -

(RSO: Clear shooter individually- establish physical contact with shooters)

- 1. Gun on safe
- 2. Remove magazine/munition;
- 3. Open the action;
- 4. Inspect the chamber – must be empty;
- 5. Close the actn **and dry-fire-gun** down range;
- 6. Re- Open the action (present gun for inspection by RSO)
- 7. Stand fast - Wait your turn to be cleared – **do not move;**
(RSO make physical cntct with each shooter that is cleared)

Clear! -

(RSO: Clear shooter individually establish physical contact with shooters)

- 1. Let the action go forward (under control) – depress trigger;
- 2. Stand-fast: Wait for the command “Range Clear” before any movement occurs;

Range Clear!

- 1. Move from the Firing Line/ Actn open/Muzzle cntrl/place gun in rack/sling gun or 2. Holster gun;

RSO: delegate Flag change from Red to Green

Status of a holstered gun during a Range Clear (RC):

- **No handling or drawing of the holstered gun during a RC!;**
- **Pistol:** Slide f/ward, Hammer down, Mag.-well empty, no mag inserted;
- **Revolver:** Hammer down/cylinder closed/no cartridge in cylinder

Range Brief

Welcome the Kananaskis Gun & Archery Club. My name is _____ I am the RSO for today. This Range is template up-to-and-including – **MPR: cal.338 Lapua - HG: cal.357 Magnum – Trap: 7 ½ shot**

Safety is an individual responsibility! If you see an unsafe act = You Must STOP it! Anyone can call – Stop!

Range Lay-out:

- Down-/Up- Range, explain side-berms (not shooting into side-berms);
- Range Left-Right-of-Arc/Individual Left/Right-of-Arc;
- Explain Flags: Entrance Lease/Range/Firing-Point = Red/Green;
- Static/Firing-Line/Firing -Point(s)/Dynamic;
- Restrooms/Club House/BBQ area;
- 1st Aid-/Firefighting- Point(s) – point'em out;

Actions on:

- **Wildlife (Stop firing)** – let it go pass, no harassing of any kind);
- Fire – Structural/Grass (Fire ban – caution - smoking);
- Evac route/Muster point;
- **911**- Medical Emergency, **trng-acdnt** – Canmore Hsptl/Guide to road;
- 1st Aider & Runner (intro pers): _____ & _____;
- **Hang fire: wait 60sec** – Explain/**show loc of Misfire** Container;

Personal Protective EQPT (PPE): - Eyes & Ears (must be worn by shooters & spectators);

Miscellaneous:

- No Marijuana on the Lease at any time;
- Alcohol policy (Only when Lease clsd for the day/CRSO or delegate);
- Steel min distance: MPR 20m, HG 10m;
- Mobile phones (on vibrate);
- KGAC Consolidated Range Safety & Op's Rules are enforced;
- (If Competition = explain Comp Rules & Comp Range Commands);

The commands you will hear Today – are:

Turn the page, go thru the Range Commands and explain them;
Explain the actions which must follow the Range Commands;

Re-test shooters w. Questions:

Re-test shooters by asking them questions from the Briefing points, force shooters to reconfirming some of the Briefing points;

A.C.T.S.

- Assume gun is loaded **and readied**;
(Engage safety/de-cocking lever - if gun has any);
- Control the muzzle – safest possible direction;
- Trigger finger (flagged);
- See that the gun is unloaded – unload the gun;

P.(P).R.O.V.E.

- Point gun in safest possible direction;
(Put gun on safe - engage safety/de-cocking lever, ½ cock etc. if gun has any);
- Remove magazine/cartridges;
- Observe the chamber (must be empty);
- Verify the feeding-path; and
- Examine the bore.

If incident occurs: = 911 = render 1st Aid = call Chief RSO 1-587-315-1549 = fill out incident rpt
